TRANSPORT FOR CHRIST

Greetings, my name is Jay LeRette and I have been a missionary evangelist with the ministry of Transport for Christ for 20 years. I have ministered the last 18 years here at the Petro Truck Stop in Rochelle, Illinois. We have a 1988 Mack truck hooked to a 48 foot trailer that has been converted into a mobile chapel. The front 30 feet is the chapel area used for church services and ministry. The back 18 feet is my office and living quarters and I am sometimes there all night.

I have ten volunteer men that help me keep the ministry going 7 days a week. My desire is to have the chapel staffed 24 hours a day. The truck stop never shuts down and drivers are continually coming through the truck stop. So I am continually looking for men of good caliber, with a working knowledge of the scriptures and a burden for souls to help in this mission field.

We have worship services and Bible studies every day and evening. I carry an 8 foot cross around the parking lot and pass out tracts and Bibles. On some Sunday Mornings, I'll ride my horse around the parking lot with my saddle bags full of tracts and Bibles inviting the truck drivers to the service. I also minister and pray for them right there in the parking lot, using the horse as a mobile pulpit.

I am noticing more and more women coming through the truck stop; single women drivers and husband/wife teams. This summer the number of women transients has increased greatly -- women who are misdirected in life, without vision or purpose, just wandering the countryside by way of semi-truck. I thank God for my wife Karen's compassionate heart and weekly ladies' Bible study at the chapel, ministering to those in need in ways that are so vital.

We do a lot of family and marriage counseling, and local churches and authorities send troubled teens and families to us. I have witnessed whole



families repenting and committing their lives to Jesus for salvation.

This ministry is intense; we deal with broken, fragmented souls from literally all over the world. People from other countries will get a 6 month visa to drive a truck here in America, and with no family or loved ones it is very lonely. Many drivers are gone for weeks or months away from home and families. The temptations are great with gambling, prostitution and just reckless unaccountable lives.
